Designed by Snorre Læssøe Stephensen in 1962

KYO was designed in 1962, by Snorre Læssøe Stephensen, one of the forefathers of the Danish ceramic tradition. The collection carries traces of both Scandinavia and Japan. Both functional and sculptural, the new collection from Mazo is very Scandinavian and Japanese at the same time.
